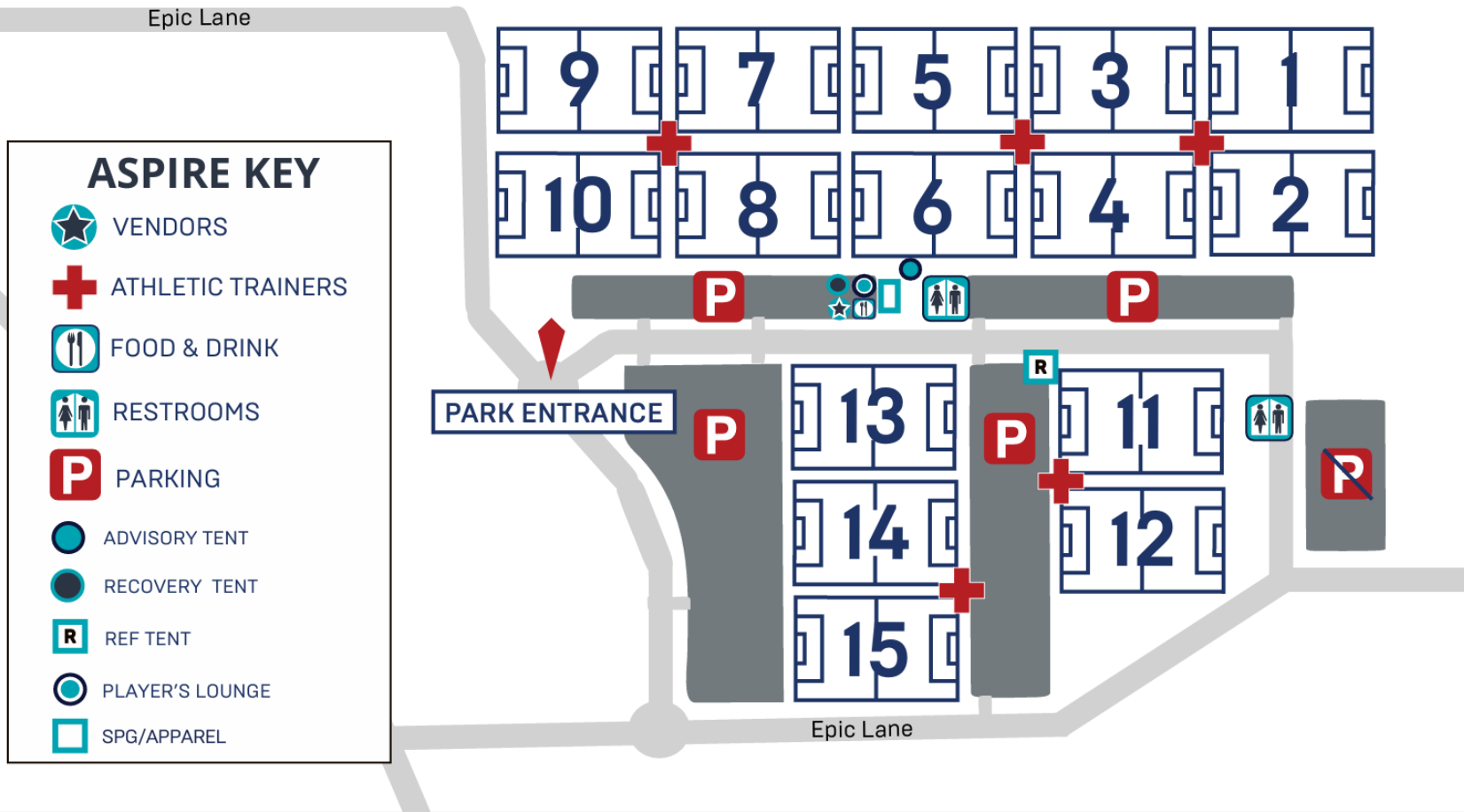

GIRLS ACADEMY CODE OF CONDUCT



- We want to ensure that matches are fair, positive and enjoyable experiences for everyone involved: players, fans, officials.
- A soccer game should be friendly and unifying - a spirited social and athletic occasion for players, coaches, referees and spectators.
- The GA has a zero-tolerance policy with regard to criticism of the referee by players, coaches, and parents.
- The GA has a zero-tolerance policy for any abusive and obscene language, violent play, violent conduct, fighting, harassment, intimidation and other behavior detrimental to the game.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on-site. Spectators caught consuming or in possession of alcohol will be asked to leave immediately.
- Spectators/Families should sit directly across from their bench where practical.
- Clubs must ensure spectators/families do not enter the sideline area.



PARKING - ADMISSION FEES

The cost for parking is \$10 per day per car OR you may purchase a pass for the weekend (up to 4 days) that is \$30 total. You will need your vehicle and license information to complete the purchase.

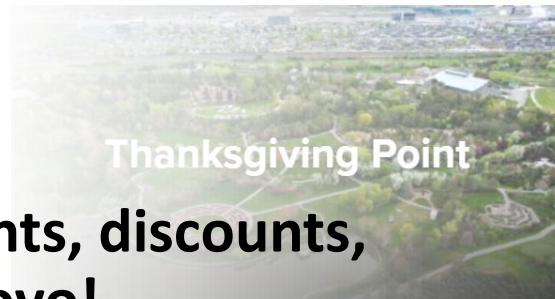
